Cyberbullying:



Bullying is any behaviour that has the intention of making someone feel sad, upset or unsafe.

It can be physical, verbal or indirect and is often repetitive.
It uses electronic communication and the internet to do exactly the same thing.
In some ways, this can be worse because it allows bullying to occur 24 hours a day.



WhatsApp

Whatsapp is a messaging app.
It is available on smart phones, enabling the user to send unlimited messages to phone contacts individually, or as part of a group for free through text, photo and video.

Due to there being no cost to the user, Whatsapp is sometimes used for cyberbullying.

The minimum age to use Whatsapp is 13 years old.

Anyone using Whatsapp, agrees in the terms of service that certain personal information is collected including the mobile phone number, billing and device information.

Project Details

Construction of a new 2 storey school on the West Heath School site to replace the existing building. Once the new school is complete the existing school buildings will then be demolished and the area will be landscaped and play/activity areas formed.

Works commenced late January 2018

Target completion August 2019

Works carried out so far

Formed a bellmouth off Wakeford Road for new site entrance and Haul Road on site, see pictures.

Installed new gate to alley way for an emergency exit, please see pictures.

New steps and gate have been installed to create a pedestrian access to site, see pictures.

Stripped top soil and stored on site and dismantled the MUGA and set aside for re-use.

Removed Chicken Coup.

Installed temporary porta-cabins for dining facilities for the school, see pictures.

Tarmacked an additional 300sqm for the children's play area, see pictures.

Works coming up

Excavate and concrete foundations for new school.

Install base for Tower crane.

Block work up to damp proof course in readiness for the new concrete plank ground floor.

Demolish existing dining room and kitchens (the Annex).
