Uniform Policy

Audience

This policy is intended to be read by parents of children at West Heath Primary School.

Aims

Uniform is compulsory at West Heath Primary School. We believe that wearing uniform promotes a sense of belonging and unity. Parents have expressed support for a whole school uniform policy and agree with the school that wearing the uniform helps to maintain our calm school approach.

Dress Code

- Grey trousers orskirt
- Grey pinafore dress
- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt
- Red jumper /cardigan, with school crest
- Black shoes no boots, trainers or pumps
- Plainred/grey/blackheadscarf(Muslimgirls.)Scarvescoveringthefacewillnotbe permitted.
- White, grey, red, black socks/tights-no stripy or patterned tights/socks with skirts and dresses.

Hair, Jewellery and Makeup

- No jewellery or makeup is permitted, this includes nail varnish.
- Mohicans, coloured extensions, tramlines and patterned hair are not permitted



Physical Education

- Plain Black shorts (no logos)
- White round neck t-shirt (no logos)
- Black pumps
- One- piece swimming costume (girls KS2)
- Swimming trunks (no knee length shorts) boys KS2
- Trainers for outdoor PE & Games
- Long hair tiedback
- · School sports hoodie with school logo and name on back
- Plain Black tracksuit bottoms (no logos)





Jewellery

• A small pair of stud earrings and a watch (for those children who can tell the time) are the only acceptable items of jewellery

Hair

- Long hair must be tied back for PE lessons.
- Mohicans, coloured extensions, tramlines and patterned hair will not be permitted. These fashion hairstyles should be kept for school holidays.
- Largeheadbandsandbowsarenotpermitted. Children will be asked to remove the hair piece if appropriate.

Makeup

• Make up (including nail varnish) is not permitted, this also applies to nonschool uniform days and school parties.

Trainers and long boots

• Trainers and long boots are <u>not</u> allowed to be worn inside. In the event that a child attends school in trainers or boots they will receive a strike.

If a child attends school without correct uniform (including PE kit) a strike will be issued in the child's Passport toSuccess.

West Heath Primary School expects ALL pupils to wear correct uniform all of the time!
