# Year 4 Trip

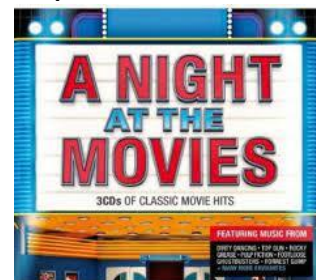
