

Hello to all of our amazing West Heath Primary School children

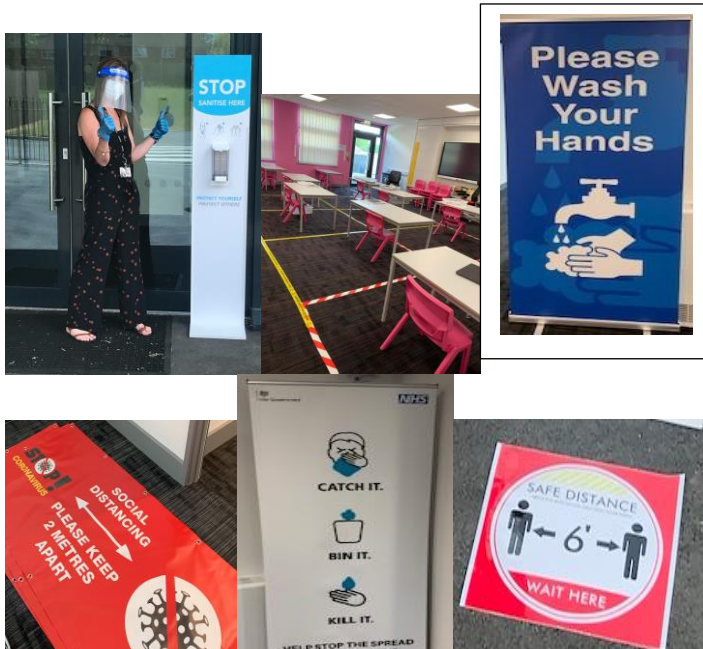
(4th June 2020)
